### L'“AUTOGÉNOMOTRICE ÉLECTRIQUE”

San Paolo, Brésil, 27.—Un prétre italien, le Père Antonio d'Angelo s'est livré à des expériences intéressantes sur un appareil de son invention, l'“autogénomotrice électrique”, destiné à remplacer les combustibles jusqu'ici pour mettre en action toute industrie mécanique.

Cet appareil 23 par lui-même génératrice d'électricité; il fonctionne au moyen d'un outillage mécanique pouvant produire n'importe quelle force.

L'“autogénomotrice électrique” se fait applicable aux automobiles, aéropâles, trams, vapeurs, et n'importe quel moyen de transport. Les expériences accomplies en présence de techniciens auraient donné d'excellents résultats et l'inventeur aurait pris un brevet pour le monde entier.

Les journaux brésiliens, en s'occupant de cette invention, déclarent que l'on est à la veille d'un des plus grands événements scientifiques que l'histoire ait enregistrés.

### Le crucifix au prétoire

Paris.—Protestant contre la condamnation des anarchistes Sacco et Vanzetti, le Midi socialiste de Toulouse écrit: "On refuse encore à croire qu'une telle monstruosité puisse s'accomplir. Il n'y a donc pas de Christ au-dehors des prétoires américains?"

"Nous ne savons pas, écrit à ce sujet la "Croix", s'il y en a dans les prétoires du Massachusetts, mais nous savons qu'il n'y en a plus dans les prétoires français. Les lois laïques les en ont décrôchées et, en certaines villes, elles les ont jetées à la voirie pour permettre en exécution l'odieux blasphème révolutionnaire.

Puisque le Midi socialiste pense avec raison que la présence du Christ est une garantie de justice, nous espérons qu'il s'unira à nous pour demander qu'on replace le crucifix dans les prétoires par l'abrogation de la loi laïque qui les en a enlevées."

### La persécution

#### en Equateur

QUITO.—L'exemple du Mexique est contagieux. La république de l'Equateur commence aussi à persécuter les catholiques. Pour le moment, ce sont surtout les Ordres religieux qui sont l'objectif de la laïcité des sectaires. Plusieurs de leurs membres ont été jetés en prison. Un couvent de Dominicains a été transformé en caserne et occupé par la troupe. Les Sociétés de jeunes gens catholiques dirigées par des Jésuites, ont été dissoutes.

Depuis l'assassinat de l'inoubliable président, García Moreno, la lutte n'a jamais cessé entre les francs-maçons qui sont puissamment organisés, et les catholiques. Pour combattre ceux-ci certains, bien des pays, les sectaires libéraux, qui, pourtant appartiennent tous à la classe aisée, ont fait alliance avec les communistes contre l'Eglise.
