### **BRITISH TO CARRY** HEAVY TAX LOAD

Resolute in Restoring the Export Trade Unhampered by Absurd Regulations.

London, March 19.—Speaking in the House of Commons today on the second reading of the appropriation bill, George Lambert, former civil Lord of the Admiralty, said there were two budgets this year, aggregating £1; 500,000,000 and that if this sum were to be raised by taxes, it would mean fifteen shillings in the pound income tax and the doubling of the duties on leather and sugar. The Chancellor of the Exchequer, the member added, would have to resort to borrowing. He appealed to the government to be resolute in restoring the export trade, unhindered and unchecked by any "absurd government regulations."
