

and each and every such entry shall be signed both by the purchaser and vendor together with the number of such certificate, note or paper writing, which the said vendor shall preserve: and every such certificate, note or paper writing shall correspond in number and other details with
 5 the entry made in the register or book; and any Apothecary, Chemist, Druggist, vendor or retailer of Medicines herein offending shall for the first offence incur a penalty of *forty dollars*, and on being convicted shall stand committed until payment of the said penalty, and for the second offence be disqualified by the Board of Governors of the
 10 College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada, from ever practising as an Apothecary, Chemist, Druggist, vendor or retailer of Medicines in the said Province: Provided always, that nothing herein contained, shall prevent any Apothecary, Chemist, Druggist, vendor or retailer of Medicines, from selling any article of poison used in trade, Arts
 15 or manufactures to any person of the full age of twenty one years, who is personally known to him, without any such certificate, note or paper-writing as aforesaid, but every such Apothecary, Chemist, Druggist, vendor or retailer of Medicines shall nevertheless be bound to make an entry of the same in the book or Register to be by him kept as aforesaid, together
 20 with all the other details required in the case of persons producing a certificate, note or paper-writing as aforesaid.

Penalty for contravening this section.

Proviso: as to poisons sold to known persons, to be used in manufactures.

VIII. Every Apothecary, Chemist and Druggist, vendor or retailer of Medicines, in the Province aforesaid, shall be bound carefully to keep in some private and safe place in his Shop or Dispensary, and in yellow
 25 bottles, so as to be clearly and easily distinguished, with proper and legible labels in large letters upon each bottle or vessel, in order to prevent mistake either by himself, his apprentice, or other person entrusted with his Shop or Dispensary,—all Arsenic, Strychnine Corrosive Sublimate, Chloroform, or such other article of poison aforesaid, generally
 30 known under the denomination of rank poison, under the penalty of *twenty dollars*, in case of disobedience, and shall be committed until payment of the same.

Rank poisons to be kept in yellow bottles.

IX. The Board of Governors of the College of Physicians and Surgeons shall, by virtue of this Act, have authority to depute any three Governors of the said College to enter the Shop or Dispensary of any Apothecary, Chemist, Druggist, vendor or retailer of Medicines, in order to ascertain if the requirements herein above-mentioned, with respect to Arsenic, Strychnine, Corrosive Sublimate, Chloroform, Prussic Acid, or other such article of poison as aforesaid, be complied with; and such
 40 Apothecary, Chemist and Druggist, vendor or retailer of Medicines, who shall refuse admittance at any hour of the day, between ten in the forenoon and four in the afternoon, to his Shop or Dispensary, to the persons authorized to the intent aforesaid—such persons producing and exhibiting a written authority to the intent aforesaid—shall for every
 45 such offence incur a penalty of *twenty dollars*, and on conviction, shall be committed to the common Gaol until payment of the same.

College of Physicians to depute persons to visit Druggist shops and see that this Act is obeyed.

X. In all cases in this Act provided for, in which increasing fines are to be levied in accordance with repetition of the offence, the Court shall have power and it is hereby authorized, to substitute therefor, unless
 50 forthwith paid, an imprisonment in the common Gaol in which the offence shall have been so committed, for periods of not less than one month for the first offence, nor less than two months for the second offence, nor less than three months for the third offence.
