of the "*Religieuses Sœurs Hospitalières de St. Joseph de l'Hotel Dieu de Montréal,*" and also to acquire and take by donation, devise or otherwise, and to hold for the use of the Poor of the Hotel Dieu aforesaid, by the name of the "*Religieuses Sœurs Hospitalières de St. Joseph de l'Hotel Dieu de Montreal, Administratrices du bien des Pauvres du dit Hotel Dieu,*" and according to the Rules and Regulations of the said Institution, all 5 and every kind of real property lying in this Province, or *constituts* or *rentes foncières* secured upon such property, and all sums of money in the public funds of the United Kingdom, or secured by Debentures upon 15 the public revenue of this Province, and all other kinds of property whatsoever,—so that the total fixed and permanent revenue arising from such property do not exceed three thousand pounds currency per annum, 20 over and above the property which the said Community shall legally possess and hold for their own use at the time of the passing of this Act,—and so that the fixed and permanent revenue derived there- 25 from do not exceed in the whole five thousand pounds currency per annum, over and above the property which the said Community shall lawfully possess and hold at the time of the passing of this 30 Act, for and on behalf of the Poor of the Hotel Dieu aforesaid,—and to sell and alienate the said property whether acquired before or after the passing of this Act, and whether held for their own use or for the use of 35 the Poor, and to purchase and acquire in the stead and place thereof, any other property of what kind soever; provided the total yearly revenue of the property so possessed at any time by the said Commu- 40 nity for their own use by virtue of this Act, shall not at any time exceed the said sum of three thousand pounds currency, and that the total yearly revenue of the property so possessed at any time by the said Community 45 for the use of the poor aforesaid by virtue
