

poration, under the inspection of the Chief Justice of this Province, and the Justices of the Court of King's Bench for the time being, as visitors of the said Community or Corporation, and to appoint

senior Members, or more of the said Community or Corporation (whereof his Majesty's Attorney General and Solicitor General and Advocate General for the time being, shall be three,) as Governors or Benchers of the said Community or Corporation, who, or the majority of them, shall have power and authority to appoint a Librarian and a Treasurer if need be, and the

senior Members of the said Community or Corporation, shall thereafter for the time being, in all time to come, including his Majesty's Attorney General, Solicitor General and Advocate General, for the time being, be Governors or Benchers of the said Community or Corporation.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that a General Assembly of the Members of the said Community or Corporation, or as many of them as can conveniently attend, of whom the Attorney General, Solicitor General or Advocate General for the time being, shall be one, or shall have been duly called or summoned to attend thereat, shall be held within after the passing of this Act, at

pursuant to previous notice of at least days, to that effect, to be given by any of the senior Members of the said Community or Corporation, at which Assembly, such By-Laws, Rules and Regulations as may be necessary for the organization, good government and order of the said Community or Corporation, and for the purposes of this Act, shall be passed by a majority of votes, and the same when so passed, and openly and publicly read, shall be entered into a Book or Register to be kept for that purpose; and the said By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, being approved by the said visitors herein-before-mentioned, or a majority of them, shall be the By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Community or Corporation, liable, nevertheless, to be altered, amended or repealed at any subsequent General Assembly of the same, under the inspection of the visitors aforesaid.

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the time at which the succeeding General Assembly of the said community or corporation shall be annually held, shall be appointed at the first General Assembly to be held as aforesaid. Provided always, that if any such General Assembly shall not be held at the time, when, by this Act, the same ought to have been held, the said community or corporation shall not be taken or considered to be dissolved, but the said General Assembly shall thereafter be held as soon as possible, at
