An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Hamilton and Port Dover Railway Company.

WHEREAS the Hamilton and Port Dover Railway Company have Preamble. represented by their Petition, that they have entered into contracts for the completion of the Railway authorized by their Act of incorporation, and have prayed that the time thereby allowed for commencing their said Railway may be extended, and for power to extend their line of Railway westward to some point on the Detroit River or Lake Erie, and eastward to the Suspension Bridge, by Cayuga or some other convenient route, and that certain other amendments may be made to their said Acts to facilitate the carrying out of the said undertaking, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of their Petition; Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- I. For and notwithstanding anything in their special Act, the Railway Act 16 Vict. Clauses Consolidation Act or in any other Act contained, the said special c. 102, declar15 Act shall, and is hereby declared to be in full force and effect, and the corporate powers of the said Hamilton and Port Dover Railway Company time allowed shall continue in force, provided they shall commence the construction of for commenct the works therein mentioned, and expend ten per cent, on the amount of the work, their capital within three years from the passing hereof.
- 20 II. It shall be lawful, for the said Company to extend their line of Rail-Power to exway westward from Port Dover to any point on the Detroit River or Lake the Rail-Erie, and eastward from Port Dover to the Suspension Bridge; and to such to Lake Erie extensions all and every the provisions and enactments of the Act of in- and eastward corporation of the said Company shall apply and extend as fully as to the to the Suspension Bridge.
