any field of study. Value: \$2,000.00 annually. Purpose: To encourage Canadian disabled students to pursue university studies with the ultimate objective of obtaining a first university degree. Duration: One academic year-may be renewed upon application. Conditions: Candidates must be disabled according to the following 1975 United Nations Declaration:

> "A disabled person is any person unable to ensure himself or herself wholly or partly the necessities of a normal individual and/or social life, as a result of deficiency, either congenital or not, in his or her physical or mental capabilities."

Candidates must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents who have lived in Canada for at least two years as permanent residents. Candidates must be entering or currently enrolled in a first undergraduate degree program in a Canadian postsecondary institution. Holders of an undergraduate degree are NOT eligible for the scholarship. 
