**CITY OF MISSISSAUGA PUBLIC NOTICE**

IN THE MATTER of Sections 12, 13 and 17 of The Planning Act, R.S.O. 1970, c. 349  
 AND IN THE MATTER of an application to the Minister of Housing by the Corporation of the City of Mississauga for approval of its Official Plan as adopted by By-law 509-80  
**TAKE NOTICE THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Mississauga, on the 23rd day of June, 1980, enacted and passed By-law 509-80, a by-law to concurrently repeal the existing Official Plan and to adopt a new Official Plan for the City of Mississauga. This Notice is a continuation of the public participation program initiated in 1975.

**PURPOSE OF THE APPLICATION**  
 This Application is to obtain the Minister's approval of the Official Plan as adopted by By-law 509-80. By-law 509-80 repeals the former Official Plan of that part of the former Town of Mississauga including all amendments, the Official Plan of the former Town of Streetsville and former Town of Port Credit and the Official Plan of that part of the former Town of Oakville which became part of the City of Mississauga, all under authority of The Regional Municipality of Peel Act, R.S.O. 1973 c. 60. Certain previous Official Plan Amendments, however, are readopted.  
 The By-law also adopts a new Official Plan which sets out the intentions of the City of Mississauga with regard to growth, development, change, conservation, and preservation. The Official Plan describes the general policies concerning the physical, social, and economic development and redevelopment of the City. On these matters, the plan, provides a framework for decision-making by City Council and a guide for citizens and for public and private agencies.

**EFFECT OF THE BY-LAW**  
 The by-law adopts a new Official Plan which replaces the Official Plan previously adopted by Council in July, 1978. The new Official Plan incorporates a series of modifications recommended by the Ministry of Housing as a result of its circulation of the July, 1978 Official Plan; includes reference to amendments adopted by City Council since July, 1978; and also includes matters which have arisen subsequent to Council's earlier adoption. All revisions to the Official Plan were considered at open Council meetings, however, not all modifications recommended by the Ministry of Housing have been included in the revised Official Plan.
