Instrument flying for instructors only and testing for navigation flight carried out. Ceiling lifted somewhat in afternoon. No night flying.</p> <p>Total flying time 49.10 hours.</p>	
	29-8-42		<p>Funeral Services for GB 658484, Corporal Davies, F., held at Camp Borden. Internment with full military honours to place in the Barrie Cemetery, Military Section.</p> <p>At 0800 hours ceiling 550 feet, visibility 3/4 miles, light wind from North. Conditions improved later in day and dual flying washed in at 1400 hours, continuing until 1715 hours. No night flying.</p> <p>Total flying time 77.25 hours.</p>
