

therewith; and in reply I have to inform you that payment of the account is withheld until the receipt from you of an exhaustive report upon the account in question which amounts to so large a sum and contains no details of the medicines furnished.

You have not even quoted your authority for sending Dr. Hanson upon such an extended tour. A general direction was given to employ Dr. Hanson, but no record of any special authority for this tour can be found.
