

conducted under the auspices of religious denomination or benevolent societies and towards the support and maintenance of the same the Government contributes wholly or in part as the circumstances connected with the management of the school require. You will therefore understand that both Catholic and Protestant Churches conduct schools for the benefit of Indian children, with the support of the Government above referred to.

I am unable to state that there is any difference in the degree of benefit derived by the pupils attending schools conducted by one sect over those attending a school conducted by another. All are, as a rule, required to employ certificated teachers.
