

1st The medicine supplied to the Indians by Dr. Hartling, if given under his direction, & no Doctor should be allowed to the Indians and the number of the prescriptions given in each case by Dr. Hartling to be Indians & Doctors except the said and knowing the medicine supplied should be stand in the account.

2nd Dr. Johnson must specify the Standard in both cases, and Dr. Johnson should be required to supply him with sufficient numbers of those goods before he can be allowed to do more than he is in a position to do but as in the case of horses the usual charge for Standard
