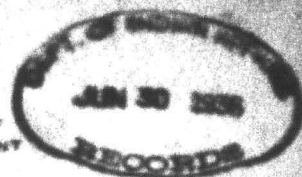

I attach hereto a copy of a letter from Mr Wm. McLaws, Barrister, of Bassano Alberta, who has been retained by Mr Pierson also of Bassano, to act for the winding up of the affairs of the above named purchaser who died suddenly early this spring.

You will note that Mr McLaws asks for information on several matters and I would appreciate hearing from you at your earliest convenience.

I believe a good move has been made in leasing to James O'Leary. He has lands adjoining these Jordan parcels and is farming extensively in this district. Unfortunately, no crops have been produced in this area for years and you will note that Mr McLaws makes the observation that crops are in bad shape owing to the extreme heat of the last four or five days.
