Sir,-

I beg to inclose lease, in duplicate, to Mr. James E. Vick, covering the gypsum on portion of the Pezynos Indian Reserve, and have to request that you will kindly have the same executed by Mr. Vick and return the documents to the Department for execution by the Superintendent General, after which one copy will be returned.

Payment has been made by you on behalf of Mr. Vick for one year's rental, amounting to \$373.20, and I have to call your attention to clause in the lease which provides that, as the lessee took possession of the lands about the first of May last, he should pay at or before the signing of the lease the sum of \$155.50, which amount should be transmitted to the Department along with the lease in duplicate.
