arrangement with the various railway companies, requisitions are accepted in payment of the freight. The companies will be requested to add your name to the list of officials of the Department authorized to sign such requisitions.

Mr. Inspector Semmens has been requested to give you the shipping addresses, but if you are in doubt as to any of them, kindly communicate with the Department or the local Agents.

You will observe that the contract does not call for Holland Twines Nos. I and 2, but you are authorized to purchase from the Hudson's Bey Co. the limited quantities required by the Assimiboins and Duck Lake Agencies.

An advance of \$50.00 to meet contingencies will be sent you next month.
