



Ottawa, 26th March, 1920.

Sir:-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 18th instant, in which you report that an Indian named Hope purchased a team of horses from Mr. Thos. Reid of Selkirk and made payment thereon to the amount of \$200.00, but that there is a balance of \$334.36 in the form of a lien note due on the horses, and that Mrs. Eliza J. Hope is prepared to pay this balance from funds at her credit in the Dominion Bank, and in reply I beg to say that you are hereby authorized to issue a cheque in favour of Thos. Reid for the sum mentioned, as Mrs. Hope is anxious that payment shall be made to Mr. Reid from her funds. You should take a receipt from Mr. Reid for the amount which you pay him.
