Please let me know your choice at once. I enclose a stamped envelope for your reply, also a letter paper on which you may write me a note telling me the name and address of your delegate.

The Department will pay travelling expenses of the delegate if from outside the Greater Vancouver area. The delegate will stay in a hotel of their own choice whilst in town and will be given a return travel warrant for fares and a cheque for his meals and room on arrival at the meeting place on Wednesday, July 20th at 9.00 a.m.
