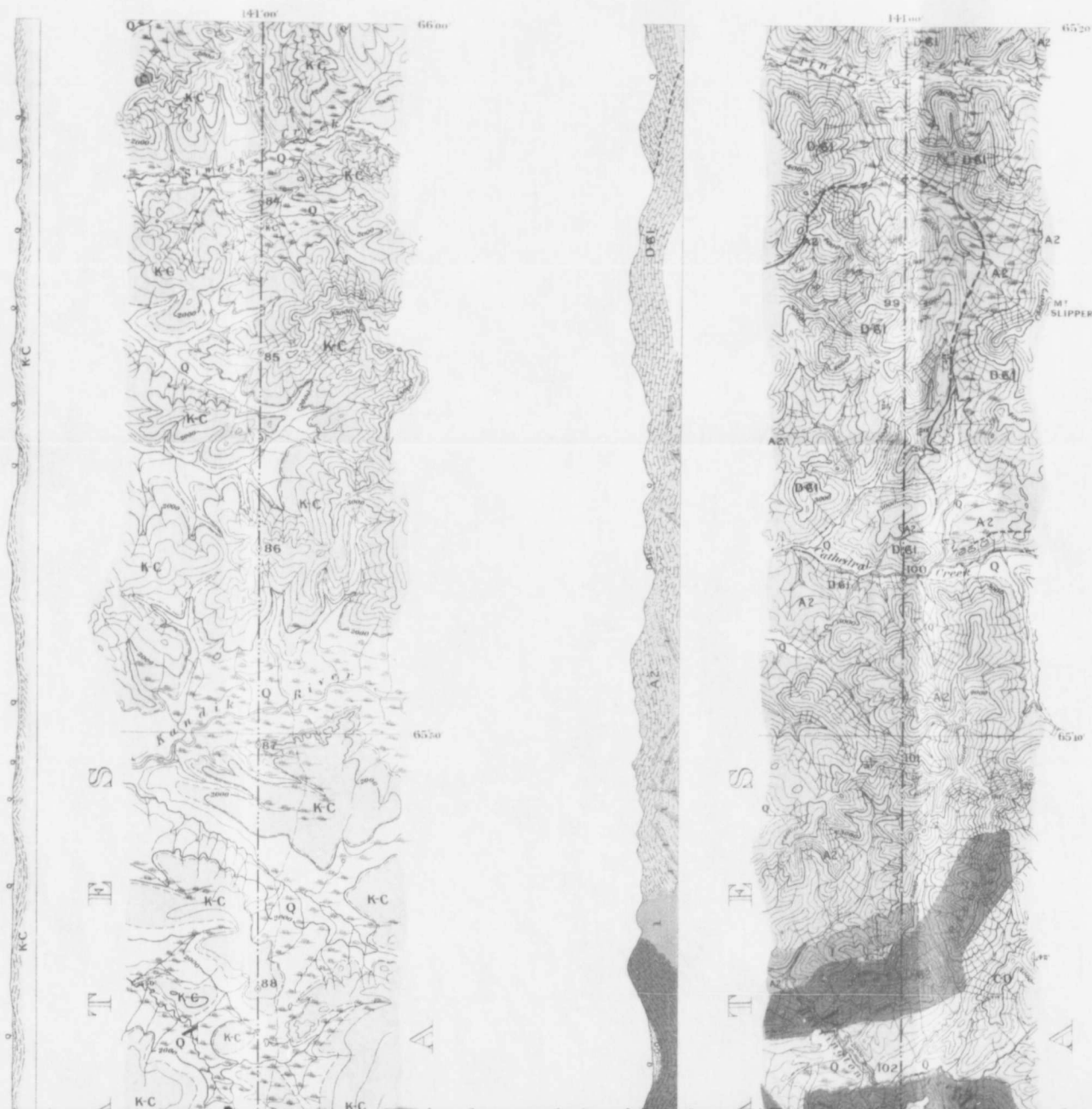

PALAEOZOIC	CARBONIFEROUS	C Carboniferous to Devonian (Shaly shales, sandstones, greywackes, conglomerates, limestones, and granites with occasional beds of fine sand interbedded with these members)
	DEVONIAN, SILURIAN, ORDOVICIAN, AND CAMBRIAN	D Devonian to Cambrian (Shaly shales, sandstones, greywackes, conglomerates, limestones, and granites with occasional beds of fine sand interbedded with these members)
	LOWER CAMBRIAN OR PRE-CAMBRIAN	A Lower Cambrian or Pre-Cambrian (Shaly shales, sandstones, greywackes, conglomerates, limestones, and granites with occasional beds of fine sand interbedded with these members)
MESOZOIC ?	IGNEOUS ROCKS	Z Igneous rocks (Granite, diorite, and other basic igneous rocks)
	PRE-MIDDLE CAMBRIAN OR DEVONIAN	1, 2 Pre-Middle Cambrian or Devonian (Shaly shales, sandstones, greywackes, conglomerates, limestones, and granites with occasional beds of fine sand interbedded with these members)
