Constitution and Laws,

- I. The title of the Society is "THE LOYAL TRUE BLUE ASSOCIATION OF BRITISH AMERICA.
- 2. There is one Grand Lodge, its title shall be "THE GRAND TRUE BLUE LODGE OF BRITISH AMERICA."
- 3. The Grand Lodge shall have jurisdiction over all District and Private Lodges.
- 4. All Warrants for the holding of Private Lodges shall be granted by the Grand Lodge, but such warrants must be signed by the Grand Master, Deputy Grand Master, and Grand Secretary.
- 5. In every County, City, District and Town, there shall be a District Lodge, provided that not less than three Private Lodges shall be necessary to constitute a District Lodge.
- 6. The Grand Lodge shall be composed of its own officers, all past Grand Masters, of good standing in the Order, and present Grand Master, Deputy Grand Master, Grand Secretary, Grand Treasurer, Grand Chaplain, Grand Director of Ceremonies, Grand Lecturers, District Masters, and all Masters and Deputy Masters of Private Lodges.
- 7. The Grand Lodge is the sole depository and guardian of the Symbols and Mysteries of the whole Order, and the source of supreme legislation for the good government, uniformity.
