At a Meeting of the Board of Directors, held at Hamilton, C. W., on the 29th January, 1858, it was

Ordered,

That the following code of Rules and Regulations be, and the same is hereby approved and adopted for the guidance and instruction of the Officers and Men in the service of the Great Western Railway Company, and that all former Rules and Regulations inconsistent with the same, be cancelled.

Ordered,

That every person in the service do keep a copy of these Regulations on his person while on duty, under a penalty of five shillings, currency, for the neglect of the same.
