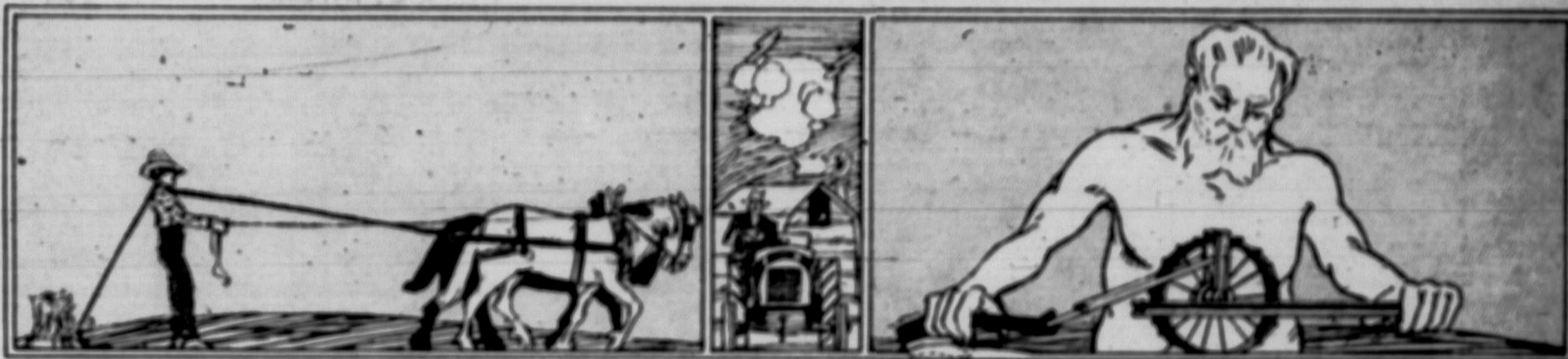

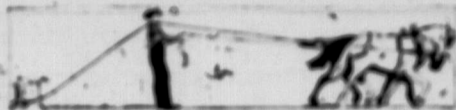

AUTOMATIC TRACTION BY PULL INSTEAD OF BY WEIGHT



If you were to fasten a rope to a stone and your lean to the other end of the rope, then put the rope over your shoulder and give the word to pull, you would find yourself with plenty of traction on the ground.
