EORGE THE THIRD, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith: To our well beloved and faithful the Legislative Councillors of Our Province of Lower Canada, and to Our beloved and faithful the Knights, Citizens and Burgesses of the House of Assembly, of Our said Province, called and chosen to Our present Provincial Parliament of

Our faid Province, and to all Our loving Subjects whom these presents may concern, Greeting: Whereas we have thought fit, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our faid Province of Lower. Canada, to dissolve this present Provincial Parliament of Our said Province, which now flands prorogued to Saturday the Twenty-eighth day of May next; We do for that end, publish this Our Royal Proclamation, and do hereby diffolve the faid Provincial Parliament accordingly, and the Legislative Councillors, and the Knights, Citizens and Burgesses of the House of Assembly, are discharged from their meeting and attendance on Saturday the Twenty eighth day of May next. And We being defirous and refolved, as foon as may be, to meet Our People of Our faid Province, and to have their advice in Provincial Parliament, do hereby make known Our Royal Will and Pleasure, to call a new Provincial Parliament, and do hereby further declare, that with the advice of Our faid Executive Council, We have this day given Orders for iffuing Our Writs in due form, for calling a New Provincial Parliament in Our said Province, which Writs are to bear Test on Saturday the Thirtieth day of this present month of April, and to be returnable on SATURDAY the EIGHTEENTH day of JUNE next, for every place except the County of Gaspe, and for the County of Gaspe, on MONDAY the EIGHTH-day of AUGUST next. Testimony whereof, we have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the great Seal of Our faid Province to be thereunto affixed.
