**TUESDAY, January 26, 1836.**

**WEDNESDAY, January 27, 1836.**

**J**OHAN MACKINTOSH, Esq. elected a Member for King's County, in the room of Daniel Brennan, Esq. whose seat had become vacant in consequence of his accepting the office of a Commissioner for ascertaining the Boundary Lines of Counties and Townships, appeared at the Bar, and having been led into the body of the House, and introduced to the Speaker by Mr. Cooper and Mr. M'Callum, two of the Members, took the Oaths and his seat.
