A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the General Assembly of this
Island stands prorogued until Thursday the Twen-
ty-eighth day of February instant :

I have thought fit further to prorogue the said
General Assembly, and the same is hereby pro-
rogued until THURSDAY the Twentieth day of
March ensuing, then to meet FOR THE DIS-
PATCH OF BUSINESS, of which all persons
concerned are required to take notice and govern
themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my hand, and the Seal of the said
Island, at Charlotte-Town, this Twenty-se-
venth day of February, in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight,
and in the Ninth year of His Majesty's Reign.
