And a further sum of One thousand five hundred £1500 for finish-Pounds, to the joint Committee of the Legislative ingpublicapart-ments in Colonial Council and House of Assembly, together with the Building. Commissioners for the erection of the Colonial Building, or as much thereof as may be deemed necessary to be laid out, in furnishing the different apartments in the said Building, intended for the use of the Legislature, Courts of Law and Equity, and the Public Library, and also in providing the most approved means of heating the same.
