The Enemy Have a Great Dread of British Mounted Fighters.

London, Dec. 27 .- The Times publishes the following despatches from its war correspondent:-"Arundel, Dec. 20 .- The force here,

"Arundel, Dec. 20.—The force here, consisting mostly of cavalry and horse artillery, have successfully checkmated a much larger force of Boers about Colesberg. The military situation demands a large increase in the cavalry. Experience here shows that the Boers greatly dread cavalry with horse artillery.

"The Boer positions here are strong, and an assault would involve terrible losses, but either flank could be readlosses, but either flank could be read-ily turned and retreat cut off if our cavalry were sufficiently numerous and the horses fit. The Boers would then be forced to attack the British

in their positions or disperse. Loya Boers say the enemy has gained few recruits in this neighborhood."

Shiploads Reported Sent From New Orleans.

New Orleans, Dec. 27.-The British consul here is authority for the statement that New Orleans has been one of the chief ports used by Boer one of the caser ports used by use in agents for securing supplies for use in the Transvaal. Corn has been one of the principal staples bought and ship-ped, without creating comment or suspicion. The British authorities, however, appear to have possessed more or less information on the subject for some time, but have been powerless to stop the shipments. The plan, the British consul says, has been to ship the grain and other supplies from New Crleans to Rotterdam, and there re-ship to ports from which the Trans-vaal could be reached. British ships were used to carry the supplies as far as Rotterdam. Investigation last night revealed the fact that the quantity of corn shipped from New Orleans to Rotterdam this season has been in excess of 3,000,000 bushels, while the legitimate trade has never required more than 400,000 bushels.


