New Automobile Law.

At Monday's sitting of the House of Assembly Hon. H. Wickwire, Minister of Highways, introduced a Bill entitled 'An Act to Amend Chapter 12 of the Acts of 1918, Motor Vehicle Act.'

Mr. Wickwire explained the principal changes. The chief alteration, he said, was the increase in fees paid by the operators of motor cycles, vehicles and trucks.
