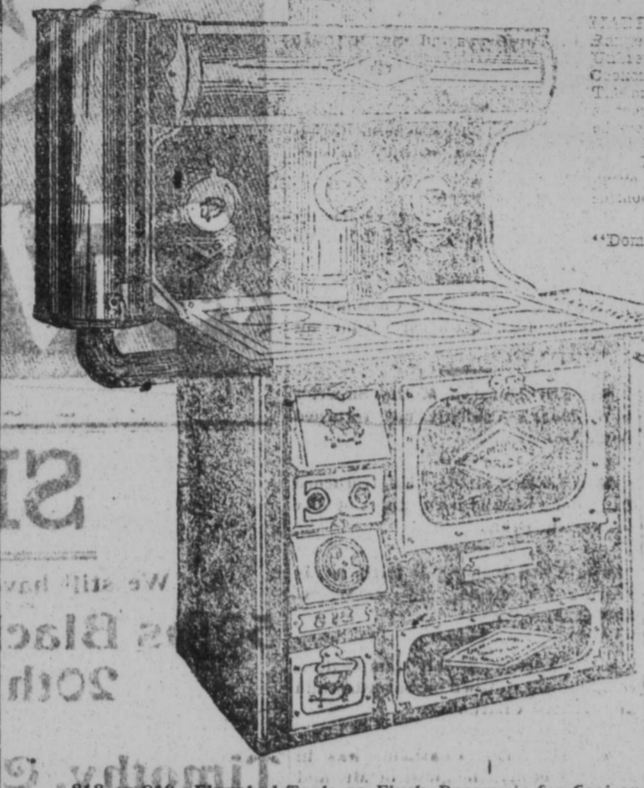
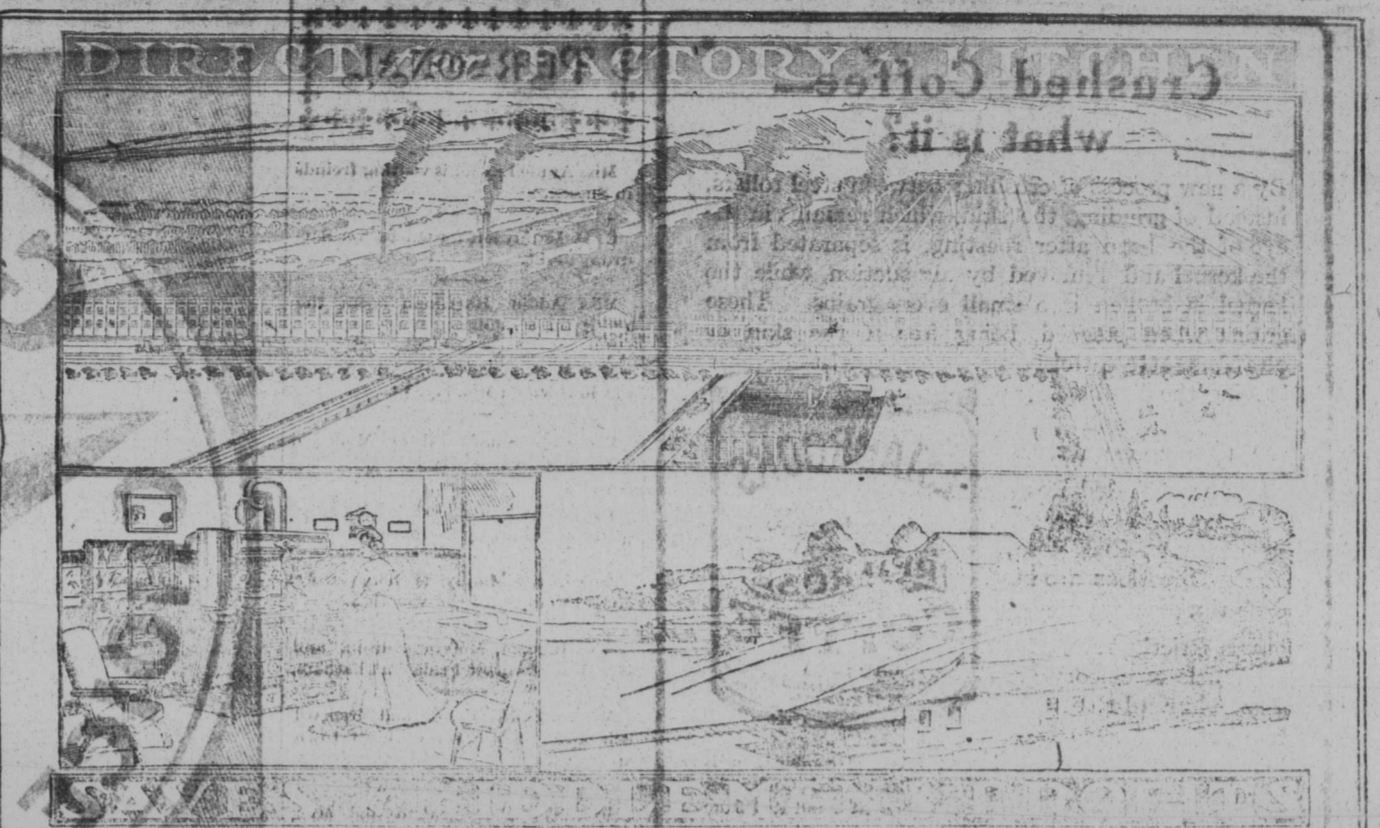
GRAND DIVISION

Hopewell Hill, May 18. - Grand Division Sons of Temperance resumed proceedings this morning with E. S. Hennigar, G. W. P., in the chair.

A communication was read from the Women's Suffrage Association of St. John, requesting the Grand Division to place itself on record in favor of granting votes to women. After some discussion a resolution was adopted expressing sympathy with the principle of woman suffrage. The propaganda committee presented a report showing the work done during the half year, and asking permission to arrange to send a lecturer and organizer for a short time into the Northern parts of the province. It was decided to make an effort to extend the organization in the Northern counties.

MEAT COSTS LESS IN CHICAGO NOW

Chicago, Ill., May 18.-A reduction of one-half cent a pound was made today in the price of the better grades of dressed beef cuts while the cheaper grades remained the same. Packers said that since the public has awakened to the fact that beef plates, chunks and rounds are as nutritious as beef loins and ribs, even though their cost is much lower, the demand for the cheap cuts has doubled. Consequently, they say, they are compelled to reduce the cost of ribs and loins in order to equalize the demand for the inexpensive parts. This latest reduction brought No. 1 ribs to 14 and No. 1 loins to 16 cents per pound, as compared with 17 and 22 cents in January.
