In addition to the various other reasons that might be addressed in favor of the required Branch your Memorialists beg leave respectfully to state that the trade of Carbonear alone, with St. John's, is greater than that of Harbor Grace as the merchants of Harbor Grace import their Goods direct, whereas most of the Carbonear merchants and traders get theirs from and through St. John s.
