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Farmers Keenly Resent Meighen Stigmatizing Them Bolsheviks

Rousing Addresses At Monster Labor Day Demonstration At Lakeside—Hon. Manning Doherty Tells of Drury Government's Work.

LAKESIDE, Sept. 5.—Condemning in no uncertain manner the "Captains of Industry" because they had failed to assume their losses with the farmers, and fearlessly flaying Hon. G. Howard Ferguson, leader of the provincial Conservative, because of his "unwarranted criticism of the Drury administration," Hon. Manning Doherty, Ontario's minister of agriculture, addressed at some length those North Oxford elements who graved the threatening elements and attended the first annual U. F. O. picnic here this afternoon.

A second speaker to champion the cause of the Farmer-Labor movement was ex-Warden John Lillio, who in a few brief remarks took up the case against Right Hon. Arthur Meighen, premier of Canada.

Resents the Imputation.
"Our premier has called us Bolsheviks," what do you think of that? He appears to think in pairs. He states that there are only two classes in Canada—his followers, who are 'building up,' and the other class, among whom are we farmers, who are 'losing' with little grumbling. With prices crashing on every side, you are wondering which way to turn. We naturally expected a deflation of prices, but hoped that it would be gradual and extend to every commodity.
