Officials Who Enlist Will Be Well Treated

(St. John Globe)
In reply to an enquiry regarding the treatment to be accorded to members of the bank's staff enlisting for active service the manager of the Royal Bank of Canada stated that officers of the bank who were members of the militia previous to August 1st and who volunteered for active service with the forces will be granted leave of absence for the period for which they have enlisted. The salaries of such officers will be paid for a fixed period. Officers of the bank who enlist for active service and who were not members of the militia previous to August 1st will probably be treated on the same basis, but it is impossible to reach a definite decision until it is ascertained how many officers of the bank will enlist. In any event, it is anticipated that all Royal Bank men going to the front will be liberally treated by the bank, both in the matter of salary and retention of positions.
