

LONDON THE GREAT.

The London City Press publishes some interesting facts and figures of London. In the metropolis there are 1,011 hospitals, in which one and a quarter millions of people are relieved, and which dispense outdoor relief to four millions annually. Twenty-five per cent of the population are paupers, and are relieved at a cost of over two and a half millions sterling. It also seems that there are many more lunatic women than men. Cabs have increased during the last ten years from 10,000 to over 19,000; 14,478 children were lost in London last year. Greater London contains an area of 448,334 acres. The population for this year is given as 5,189,186, of whom 60,252 are foreigners, 48,354 Scotch, 60,778 Irish, 3214 blind and 1972 deaf and dumb. In 1884 there were 11,705 licensed public and beer houses, and 15,519 males and 2618 females were charged with drunkenness. In the same year there were 265 persons killed and 3392 maimed by street accidents and 1,243 in public conveyances. There were 20,067 articles lost in public conveyances, of which 11,243 were recovered. There are 407 newspapers published in London.
