A., who is authorized by the Government of said Department to sell them at 80 per cent discount from face value, payable in American gold to his agents in New York City, Mess. M. Camacho, Roldan & Nephew, P. O. Box, 1809. The certificate of the Government attesting the genuineness of these stamps will be furnished when orders amount to 32 series or over. The Governor's signature will be authenticated by one of the Foreign Ministers or Consuls at Bogota. The denominations of the stamps are as follows: Postage Stamps, 5, 10, 50 cents; \$1.00; Registry Stamps, 5, 10, 50 cents, value of each series, \$2.50. Mr. Arciniegas, S. Naira, refers to the Government of Tolima, he being the only exporter and seller of said stamps either at home or abroad. Address, MR. G. ARCINIEGAS, S. Naira, Republic of Colombia.
