WHEAT IN CANADA.

Stocks of wheat in Canada at principal points of accumulation are reported as follows:

BRADSTREET'S REPORT OF STOCKS.

Total stocks in the United States and Canada, cast of the Rocky Mountains, as reported by Bradstreet's on December 16, were 87,260,000 bushels.

Total stocks in the United States and Canada a year ago were 52,956,000 bushels, according to Bradstreet's report.

THE VISIBLE SUPPLY.

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The Chicago visible supply statement of stocks in the United States and Canzada. east of the Rocky Mountains, for the week ended Dec. 23, was 58,878,000 bushels, being an increase of 1,725,000 bushels for the week. A year ago the visible supply was 28,783,000 bushels, three years ago 36,616,000 bushels, three years ago 54,443,000 bushels, and four years ago 69,958,000 bushels.

STOCKS OF OATS AND CORN.

The visible supply of oats in the United States and Canada, east of the Rocky Mountains is 5,473,000 bushels, compared with 6,000,000 bushels a year ago. The visible supply of corn is 12,361,000 bushels a year ago, according to the Chicago statement. the Chicago statement.
