

THE INTERNATIONAL LAW. Canadian Vessels in American Waters to be Accorded the Same Privileges as Native Boats.

WASHINGTON, D. C., November 11 .- The Cabinet meeting to day was principally occupied discussing the questions of constitutional and international law in connection with the subject of the proclamation recently issued by the Canadian Government, permitting American vessels to come to the relief of Canadian vessels in the waters of the Dominion only when danger, loss of life or cargo were absolutely imminent. The law upon our statute book permits Canadian vessels to enter our waters freely and assist American vessels in distress under any circumstances and to any extent. It was suggested to-day that the President should declare by proclamation that the privileges of Canadian vessels in our waters shall be precisely the same as those accorded by the Dominion to American vessels. The Cabinet were divided as to the power of the President, under the existing law, to issue such a proclamation. The whole matter was left undetermined. It will probably be decided, however, within the next few days.
