POLICE COMMITTEE

Report of Meeting held the 10th of October.

Present: Ald. Proulx, chairman, Bumbray, Roy, S guin, Martin, Gallery and Stearns.

1.—A delegation of barbers, anent the closing of barber-shops on sundays, was heard and an invitation was extended to the members of this Committee to attend a meeting of their association on Sunday, the 14th inst.

2.—Ald. Gadbois then introduced a delegation from the Laurier Political and Literary Club, who complained that some forty assaults had recently been committed upon Jews, and asked that the number of policemen be increased in No. 4 police district.

Mr. P. Bercovitch, legal adviser of the Club, promised to give all the required information to the Superintendent of Police.

3.—Submitted and read a letter from Mr. A. T. Gauthier, head clerk of the Recorders Court, concerning the advisability of appointing a chief of bailiff at the Recorder's Court.

Submitted also applications from Messrs. Larochelle & Lacasse for said position.

On motion of Ald. S guin, it was

Resolved: That, subject to an examination, as provided for in clause 142 of the Rules of Council, Mr. F. X. Larochelle be appointed chief bailiff at the Recorder's Court; but under the control of the head clerk of said Recorder's Court.

4.—On motion of Ald. Gallery, it was

Resolved: That No. 182, constable M. L. Grandchamp, be named private secretary to superintendent Campeau.

5.—A requisition for winter uniforms amounting to \$4,746.75 was submitted.
