

- Assistance to enable Canadian specialists to take part in international gatherings organised by academic associations.
- Assistance to enable Canadian specialists to participate in international conferences.
- Travelling expenses to enable Canadian specialists to give lectures at foreign universities.
- Travelling expenses and stipends to enable Canadian universities to receive foreign academics as visiting professors.
- Assistance to enable Canadian specialists to carry out joint research projects with their foreign counterparts.

Requests must be presented by Canadian participants or institutions with a minimum of six months' advance notice.

II. SCHOLARSHIPS

18. The SRE is offering 11 scholarships a year for post-graduate study or specialisation courses.

Extensions of previously-awarded scholarships will be considered, included within the number of scholarships offered.

19. Canada is offering five scholarships a year from the Canadian Federal Government and six scholarships a year from the Province of Quebec.

20. Both Parties must comply with the requirements laid down for applying for the scholarships that the two countries are offering to each other.
