

CANADA-CHINA TRADE COUNCIL

The Canada-China Trade Council (CCTC) was established in 1978.

A private, non-profit organization, the CCTC has as its objective the promotion of bilateral trade between Canada and China.

Under the sponsorship of the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade, the CCTC has maintained an office in Beijing since 1980. Members have found this office a cost-effective alternative to maintaining their own permanent staff in China, and have deemed the on-site representation and liaison service especially valuable.

All major sectors of the Canadian economy having business interests in China are represented in the Council.
