
PACKAGING MATERIALS AND THEIR USE

Corrugated Boxes




Fig 3-1 Information on Box Strength

Corrugated boxes are one of the most common packaging methods used and there are well established government and industry standards and regulations in place designed to protect their users. These boxes must be certified by the manufacturer. Weight, paper content and puncture and bursting certificates must be displayed, usually on the bottom. See figure 3-1. The tests for corrugated board involves subjecting it to the same conditions that may prevail during normal handling. See Annex 1 for a description of cardboard boxes and their application.
