Nuclear, Non-Proliferation and Disarmament Implementation Agency

The Nuclear, Non-Proliferation and Disarmament Implementation Agency has a mandate to enhance security and well-being by promoting the peaceful and safe use of nuclear and chemical technologies, and also to ensure compliance with international commitments. In addition, the Agency has responsibility for Canada's implementation of two recent multilateral treaties: the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC) and the Comprehensive Nuclear Test Ban Treaty (CTBT). These have been signed and the CWC has also been ratified. The Agency aims to ensure that Canadian law is consistent with our responsibilities under these treaties and that their implementation is not unduly harmful to Canadian industry.
