The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Howard Green, is leaving tomorrow evening for Paris where he will meet from Monday, October 26 to Thursday, October 29, with the heads of Canada's diplomatic missions in Europe and the Middle East. Following this meeting, Mr. Green will remain in Paris for a few days, during which he will be received by President de Gaulle. He will also call on the French Prime Minister and Foreign Minister and on Mr. Spaak, the Secretary General of NATO, and General Norstad, the Supreme Allied Commander in Europe.

Following his visit to Paris, the Secretary of State for External Affairs will spend three days in London where he will have the honour to be received by Her Majesty the Queen. He will call on the Prime Minister, the Foreign Secretary and the Secretary of State for Commonwealth Relations.

Mrs. Green will travel with the Secretary of State for External Affairs, who will be accompanied by the Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, Mr. Norman Robertson, the Canadian Ambassador to Washington, Mr. A.D.P. Heeney, and officials of the Department.
