Clause 2

Delete all the words after "Minister" in paragraph (h) on page 2, and substitute the following therefor:

"Fisheries and Forestry."

Clause 20

Add immediately after word "works", at line 25, in paragraph (b) on page 18, the following:

"and shall consult with the government of the province in which the works, undertakings and businesses in respect of which the specific emission standards are being prepared are situated."

The Committee has ordered a reprint of Bill C-224, as amended.
