## PRAYERS

One petition for a Private Bill was presented in accordance with Standing Order 67(1).

By unanimous consent, it was ordered,—That proceedings on the Adjournment Motion in this sitting be suspended.

Ordered,—That speeches on the motion under the Order "Government Business, numbered 16", be limited to ten minutes with the exception of the prime speakers who shall be limited to fifteen minutes.

Pursuant to Standing Order 39(4), the following two Questions were made Orders of the House for Returns:

No. 557—*Mr. Symes*

1. What was the total amount of money spent in each of the fiscal years 1972-73 and 1973-74 by the Ministry of State for Science and Technology on contracts to outside persons and organizations for research, development and other consulting services?

2. What are the names and addresses of these outside persons and organizations and what amounts of money were involved in each contract?

3. What was the purpose of each contract and title of each report submitted?—Sessional Paper No. 301-2/557.

No. 2,349—*Mr. Elzinga*

1. In 1974, what amount of money was spent throughout Canada in the National Exchange Programme for students?

2. (a) How much was spent in each province (b) which schools received such grants (c) how many students were involved from each school?—Sessional Paper No. 301-2/2,349.
