Note, that in a Bis-sextile or Leap-Year, the number of *Sundays* after Epiphany will be the same, as if *Easter-Day* had fallen One Day later than it really does. And for the same Reason, One Day must, in every Leap-Year, be added to the Day of the Month given by the Table for *Septuagesima-Sunday*: And the like must be done for the First Day of *Lent* (commonly called *Asb-Wednesday*) unless the Table gives some Day in the Month of *March* for it; for in that Case, the Day given by the Table is the right Day.
