An Act respecting Agricultural Fertilizers.

[Assented to 19th May, 197 ..]

His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts La follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as The Fertilizers Act, 1909.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-

(a) "Minister" means the Minister of Inland Revenue;

Definitions. "Minister."

(i) "fertilizer" includes every natural or artificial manure containing "Fertilizer." phosphoric acid, or nitrogen, or potash, except ordinary stable manure;

(c) "rigistration number" means the specific number given by the Min-"Registration number." ister, under this Act, to each brand of fertilizer;

(d) "agent" means any person whose name has been filed with the "Agent." Minister as provided in section 4 of this Act ;

(e) "guaranteed analysis" means the valuation of a fertilizer by the man. "Guaranteed ufacturer or agent in terms of its content of phosphoric acid, nitrogen and analysis. potash.

3. Fertilizers shall be considered as of distinct brands when differing Distinct either in guaranteed composition, trade mark, name, or in any other brands. characteristic method of marking.

4. Where the manufacturer of any fertilizer has his factory or chief place Name of of business elsewhere than in Canada, he shall file with the Minister the foreign name of a person resident in Canada, and acceptable to the Minister, or a turer's corporation having its head office in Canada, as the agent or representative agent or of such manufacturer for all the purposes of this Act; and any notice to, tive in or communication or dealing with, such agent or representative by the Canada to be Minister shall be effectual for all the purposes of this Act.

2. In default of such filing, the Minister may take any proceeding or Default of action under this Act ex parte, and without any notice to or communication filing. with such person or corporation.

5. Every brand of fertilizer offered for sale in Canada shall that a regist-Registration tration number, which shall be permanently assigned to the particular brand number. or species of fertilizer for which it is issued. The num or shall be granted gree by the Minister on the application of the manufacts er of such and of fertilizer, or his agent, and on payment of a fee of tw dollars.

6. Every application for a registration number shall be accompanied by a statement giving the following particulars :----

(a) Name of brand for which the registration number is asked. ... astration trade mark, if any ;

(b) Name and address of manufacturer ;

(c) Name and address of the person applying for registration ;

(d) Guaranteed analysis;

(e) Materials from which the fertilizer is made.

7. The registration number must be affixed by the manufacturer, or a tration agent, in a plain and legible manner, to every package of fertilizer sold or a er: how offered for sale, and shall constitute an identification of the brand. In aff addition to the registration number there must be legibly printed, on every package of fertilizer sold, the statement set out in schedule A to this Act. This condition shall be held to be fulfilled if a printed tag, bearing the Statregistration number and the statement required, is securely attached to require the package.
