SUMMARY OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF CONVOCATION HELD AT CALGARY, JANUARY 9TH AND 11TH, 1904.

All the Benchers were present with the exception of J. A. Lougheed, K.C.

It was resolved that the Discipline Committee be instructed to secure, if possible, an amendment to the Legal Profession Ordinance giving the Society power to strike off the Roll and suspend from practice any advocate for any cause for which an advocate may now be suspended or disqualified by the Supreme Court of the North-West Territories, with right of appeal to the Court en Banc.

The following Standing Committees were struck:--

Finance and Library: Messrs, Conybeare, Beck, and Muir,

Examining and Legislation: Messrs. McKay, Elwood, and Lougheed,

Reporting, Printing and Discipline: Messrs. Willoughby, Mackenzie, and Taylor.
