leave her; they then sent three Boats with 40 Men to break her up and plunder her; but before her People quitted her, they left a lighted Match in the Gun Room, which soon after blew up the Poop, and 30 of the Enemy upon it; the rest were made Prisoners, and the Schooner taken by the Boats of the *Machault* and *Chezine*. 1759.

At Eleven at Night, got under sail with the Fleet at *St. Michael* and passed by the Town of *Quebec* at Midnight, the *English* Garrison saluting us as we passed with about 200 or 300 Cannon Shot, and 100 Shells, but without doing any Execution. Proceeded down the River, and came to an Anchor at *St. John's*. 24.

The rest of this Fleet continued on their Voyage to *Bordeaux*, or to other Ports of *France*, but the *Chezine* was intercepted by the *Rippon*.

The *Machault* of 24 Guns, was taken the Year following by the *Fame*, in *Chaleurs* Bay.
