within ten days after being required so to do by the Registrar or other Officer in the service or employment of the Trinity House of Montreal, and a further like penalty for every subsequent ten days such incumbrances or obstructions shall not be removed.

No person to Section 9.—That all persons interfering with the interfere with Registrar or any other Officer in the service or the Registrar eriployment of the Trinity House of Montreal, while or other Offician the execution of the duties prescribed to him or cer of Trinity them by the present regulations, shall incur a penalty House. not exceeding ten pounds.

Regulations respecting Pilots.

No Pilot to Section 10.—That no Pilot shall lend or in any lend his manner dispossess himself of his Branch to any person Branch. whomsoever, under a penalty not exceeding ten pounds for each and every offence.

Section 11.- That no Pilet shall take charge of any Vessel as a Pilot etherwise than as his Branch powers of his empowers him, under a penalty not exceeding ten Branch.

Section 12.—That every Pilet shall provide himself with a copy of the By-law or By-laws in English and French, ordained by the Trinity House of Montreal, and retain the same about his person when in the By-laws. discharge of his duty, and exhibit the same to the Master or person in charge of the Vessel on Board of which he is acting as Pilot, for the use of such Master or person in charge, whilst the said Pilot has charge of such Vessel, under a penalty not exceeding ten pounds.

Section 13 .- That no Pilot shall disobey any summons of the Trinity House of Montreal, under a penalty not exceeding ten pounds, nor shall any Pilot in attendance upon the Trinity House of Montreal, this Corporation. absent himself until regularly discharged, under a further like penalty.

Section 14.—That every Pilot being in Montreal, and not engaged to Pilot any Vessel thence, shall, when thereunto required by the Registrar, or by the Trinity House Master, Deputy Master, or any of the Wardens of the Trinity House, repair on board and take charge of any Vessel requiring a Pilot, and continue in charge according to the tenor of the requisition made to him, under a penalty not exceeding ten pounds.
