¶ After Morning Prayer the service for the Holy Communion shall be said; and, if the Minister shall judge it expedient, the Lord's Supper shall be administered; the Collects as above directed shall be used, with the Epistle and Gospel of the Sunday; and the following Prayer for Unity, with the Collects, shall be added before the Benediction:

GOD, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, our only Saviour, the Prince of peace, give unto us and to all Christian people grace seriously to lay to heart the manifold evils of our unhappy divisions. Take away all hatred and prejudice, and whatsoever may hinder us from godly union and concord: that as there is but one body and one Spirit, and one hope of our calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of us all, so we may be all of one heart and of one soul, united in one holy bond of truth and peace, of faith and charity, and may with one mind and one mouth glorify Thee; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O LORD, we beseech Thee, let Thy continual pity cleanse and defend Thy Church; and because it cannot continue in safety without Thy succour, preserve it evermore by Thy help and goodness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

RANT, O Lord, we beseech Thee, that the course of this world may be so peaceably ordered by Thy governance, that Thy Church may joyfully serve Thee in all godly quietness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

- ¶ In Churches where there has been no Morning Service, the above directions may be followed at Evening Service, so far as they are applicable; and the Prayer for Unity, with the succeeding Collects, shall be said after the Prayer, Almighty God, our Heavenly Father, &c."
- ¶ In St. James's Cathedral Church at Toronto, Morning Prayer, according to the above Form, will be said on all the three days succeeding September the 24th.
