

AT A MEETING

Held at the LIBRARY Rooms, June 12, 1838, it
was Resolved, that the following

RULES

AND

REGULATIONS

BE PUBLISHED.

1. SUBSCRIBERS on paying twenty shillings annually, in advance, shall be allowed to read in the Library Rooms, and take Books therefrom.
2. READERS on paying Ten Shillings annually, in advance, shall be allowed to read in the Library Rooms, but *not* to take Books therefrom.
3. *Non-Subscribers* shall be allowed to take out Books on giving satisfactory security for the same, and paying such sum per diem for the perusal of each volume they may take out, as the Committee shall charge thereon.
4. No person allowed to take Books from the shelves of this Library under a penalty of 7d for each offence.
5. Any person taking a Book or Work from this Library, without the consent of the Librarian, shall forfeit a sum not exceeding 2s 6d.
6. Any person receiving books from the Library shall not transfer the same under a penalty of 2s 6d.
7. No Books or Works of general reference, Newspapers or Periodicals are allowed to be taken out of this Room.

 *The Library and Literary Rooms will be open from 9, A. M., till 1, P. M., and from 2, P. M. to second evening gun-fire.*
